Claddagh Choral has toured nationally and internationally exhitibiting Irish music and our own Claddagh Method.

The development of the voice is something we talk about a lot at Claddagh Choral. You may notice your child growing up really fast. Would you believe that the changes in the voice are changing at the same rate? There's a phenomenal difference between a 6 year old and a 10 year old singing the same song. We don't need to get into the science - but we've designed our programme around nurturing and developing the voice of children with age appropriate pedagogy and music.



#### Galway City Children's Choir Sr.

This choir is where children take their basic training to the next level, begin to sing in harmony and learn more about vocal technique. At this stage the children will take a deeper dive into the world of choral music while keeping the same idea of making it really fun! For ages 10-12

#### Galway City Children's Choir Jr.

This choir is designed for children's first few years of being a singer. It focuses on the most basic fundamentals of healthy singing and musicianship. The choice of music for this choir is accessible and fun while adopting all of the key elements we use in our more advanced groups. Children here will get a well rounded introduction to choral singing while making friends and having LOTS of fun. For ages 6-9





#### Galway City Youth Choir

This was the first choir founded by Claddagh Choral which started in 2016. This choir is the foundation of the success of Claddagh Choral. At this stage the voice makes its biggest change. Our pedagogy will help develop and nurture their voices to enable them to reach their full vocal potential. The Youth choir will cover everything from pop to barbershop to hit musicals. 
#### National / International Initiatives

#### Mountjoy Prison | SOLAS

Claddagh Choral curated an album recorded from Mountjoy prison. The album featured a collaboration between SOLAS | Learning Works and male singers who are serving life sentences in the progression unit in Mountjoy. The album went on to be the most successful recording ever in Mountjoy Prison. Off the back of this project we have worked and grown relations with organisations and singers such as the US Embassy and other Irish national bodies.
